The Rules of Professional Conduct

Groups may apply for once only to the maximum value of £1,000 and minimum of £500 per grant. If a group was successful in a phase 1 application, they could only apply in phase 2 for Essential Support. Groups that didn’t apply in phase 1, can apply for any of the three options in phase 2.
